Sycamore Canyon has received several complaints about the landscaping along the paved walking path between Camino del Toro and Sahuarita. That part of the path is maintained by Pima County. Concerned residents may use the [SeeClickFix application](#) to request "Vegetation Management" along that stretch of path.

Sycamore Canyon is responsible for maintaining the paved path from Camino del Toro south to Copper Ridge Elementary.

- The town of Sahuarita is hosting a [One Stop Recycle Drop](#) on Jan 14 from 9am-1pm. Drop off Christmas trees, cooking oil & grease, electronics, and appliances at 375 W Sahuarita Center Way.
- The City of Tucson's [TreeCycle](#) program is up and running. You can drop off your tree at Purple Heart Park during daylight hours, seven days a week. The city grinds the trees and uses them for compost.
