
HOA know-how

Parking

Did you notice the inoperable vehicle that was parked in the pool parking lot for months? The CC&R's prohibit the parking of vehicles in such a state (Article IV, Section 4.2, subsection s).

Management was notified of the vehicle's continued presence and had it towed. Other vehicles that have remained parked for extended periods are also being towed. (See Article IV, Section 4.2, subsection bb)

Please note that the parking lots are not to be used as longterm parking or as a place to abandon vehicles.
