HOA know-how

Residential streets

Residential paved streets in Tucson are customarily 24' wide. When designing Phase 1 (what is currently developed), the choice was made to have narrower streets at 22' wide. Planners hoped this would slow traffic in residential areas.

Because our streets are narrow, it is unwise to park on the street. Pima County Sheriffs are allowed to tow cars they deem a problem.

Our CC&R's require cars to be kept "in garages, carports, (and) residential driveways of the Owner".
