Master Association and Sub-Associations

ALL residents of Sycamore Canyon belong to the Master Association. Our monthly dues (currently \$77/month and being raised 20% as of April 1) pay for landscaping, the pool, trash services, taxes, and administrative fees.

For residents in the Enclave, Reserve, and the Preserve gated communities, you also have sub-associations. Your additional dues cover landscaping and road/gate maintenance *in your community only*. COMBATING BUFFELGRASS Our invasive species

Buffelgrass has become the bane of the Sonoran Desert since it was brought here for erosion control in the 1930s. It grows in crowded patches, competing with native plants for nutrients and water. Open spaces between native vegetation fill with buffelgrass, occupying areas where wildflowers typically bloom and erasing the natural gaps that prevent the spread of wildfires.
