The [Sycamore Canyon CC&Rs](#) (Article IV, Section 4.2, subsection t) states, “vehicles... are to be kept in garages... [and] residential driveways of the Owner.” Several homeowners are parking their vehicles either next to their driveways or on the landscaping strips. Over time, that will affect the drainage of your property.

As an alternative, please submit an ARC request for a driveway extension. Some homeowners choose pavers or concrete to work around this situation.
