#### **WEEDS**

We appreciate your efforts to help us maintain the appearance of our beautiful community and showcase what Sycamore Canyon has to offer! Keeping your front and side yards weed-free and properly manicured helps keep the community clean and inviting.

If you notice weeds in your front or side yards, please do your best to remove them as soon as possible to avoid unnecessary fines. We recommend treating larger areas of weeds with post-emergent before pulling them. Post emergent is the most effective way of killing existing weeds by penetrating the root.
