#### SUB-ASSOCIATIONS

There are four gated communities within Sycamore Canyon, The Retreat, The Enclave, and The Preserves all have their own sub associations, rules, and management companies. Residents within those communities pay dues both to Sycamore Canyon as a whole, and another set of dues for their sub association management company. If you are a resident in one of those gated communities, anything that happens behind your gate is your sub association's responsibility.

Block B (at the south end of Rustling Leaf Trail) is different. Block B is also managed by CCMC. Residents pay into the Master Association and have additional quarterly dues to cover behind-the-gate road maintenance and gate upkeep.

- 3. Obtain original pool plans to determine the layout under the deck. We would like to add more shade to the pool! (postponed)
- 4. Have pool caulking cleaned (scheduling with contractor)
- 5. Have pool equipment replaced-COMPLETED!
- 6. Collect bids to re-paint the wash railings throughout neighborhood.
- 7. Educate neighborhood about the upcoming parking enforcement vote.
